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<u>Overview:</u> This class will introduce techniques for basic data analysis and inferential statistics. Topics covered will include Frequency Distribution, Central Tendency, Variance, Probability, Normal Distribution, Sampling, Estimation and Hypothesis Testing. **Prerequisite: MATH 121** or equivalent.

**Textbook:** Business Statistics for Contemporary Decision Making, 7<sup>th</sup> ed. by Ken Black.

<u>Course Format:</u> The class format will *not* be traditional lecture. Instead, we will adopt a blended learning or "flipped classroom" approach (see <a href="http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Flip\_teaching">http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Flip\_teaching</a> for a description).

## **Grading Components:**

- Assignments (40%) Students will setup/maintain a course blog where all assignments are posted.
- Exams (50%) There will be 3 in-class exams and a comprehensive final.
- Project (10%) Students will complete a data analysis project and submit a report.

## **Grading Criteria**

Exams, assignments and the final will be assigned numeric scores and I'll track a percentage for each course component. The weighted average of these percentages will determine your final grade using traditional % thresholds:  $\geq$ =90% you will earn at least an A-; likewise,  $\geq$ =80% B-,  $\geq$ =70% C,  $\geq$ =60% D-; and  $\leq$ 60% F
