2016-2017 University Live-on Requirement

First-Year and Sophomore students who are single, under 21 years of age, with a home address outside of Pueblo County MUST live on campus two academic years (4 complete semesters). Credits taken concurrent with high school and/or credits attained through Advanced Placement (AP) CLEP, International Baccalaureate or similar programs do not apply towards living experience.

Students seeking an exemption from the live-on requirement for housing must complete a Housing Exemption Form and receive approval by the Department of Residence Life and Housing.

All residential students are required to have a meal plan.

Students failing to meet these requirements will be assessed the lowest price residence hall (double room rate) and board charges.

Any exceptions to this requirement must be approved by the University Housing Office.
